We invite you on our journey to increase the representation of Latinx Educators.



### **INCREASING ACCESS TO HIGHER EDUCATION**

The LEC helps raise funds for future educators and connects them with vital scholarships for higher education opportunities. In 2021, the LEC partnered with Hispanic Development Fund and provided \$10,000 in scholarships through the Cambio para Cambio campaign. Additionally, Avila University committed scholarships to members of the LEC who are interested in pursuing their Bachelor's in Education.
